Camp California Conditions Of Enrollment

1. Refunds - camp fee refunds must be applied for, 30 days before camp start date. All fees will be returned except the \$200 non-refundable administration fee. No refunds will be given on late arrivals or early departures, or cancellations made 29 days before camp start date. Due to the seasonal nature of camping, and commitments by Camp California to facilities and staff, no refunds or credit of camp fees can be given for any portion of an incomplete session as the result of late or early arrival/ departure, dismissal for cause, withdrawn for any reason. Parents/Guardians and campers recognize the risk that camp may not complete a session and assume the risk of full loss of camp fees paid to Camp California which sum is agree to be fair and reasonable sum due to the camp as and for liquidated damages. All claims for camp fee refunds are expressly waived and released by the Camper, Parents/Guardians .
2. Camper Arrivals/departures - Campers are to arrive on Sundays between 1-3, and depart on Fridays before 1 pm. Campers must give the camp office 24 hours notice in case of non-medical early departure. Parents/Guardians are limited to Sunday only visitation unless arrangements have been made in advance with the camp director. Parents/Guardians must provide camp staff with valid photo id, and sign in and out with the camp office. Campers also must sign in and out if leaving campus with or without a guardian, camper under 18 must have permission in writing to leave campus on their own or as a group.
3. Campers Fees Include: Room and board, entire program, (nutritional information, lifestyles classes,) most crafts, most sporting activities, admission and transportation to most planned field trips, most sports equipment is provided, most books, post and pre camp support program. Camp California's fees do not include laundry costs, shopping trips, and optional off campus activities.
4. Parents/Guardians and Campers agree to abide by rules and regulations set out by Camp California. Camp rules have been set out to protect campers safety and health. Camp California reserve the right to terminate any agreements with Camper or there Parents/Guardians, if in the camps sole judgment, the campers conduct is not in the best interest of the camp. If the Camper is dismissed or voluntary decides to withdraw no refund granted on remaining portion of camp fees. Once dismissed it is the sole responsibility of the Parents/Guardians or Camper to arrange immediate transportation off campus at the Campers or Parents/Guardians own expense. Camp California assumes not responsibility for acts committed by Campers which are in violation of camp rules and regulations or that violate Municipal, Provincial, or Federal Laws. Camp California also reserve the right to search personal property of each camper.
5. Parents/Guardians must provide Camp California will all Medical and Health Forms prior to camp, as well as all pertinent information regarding, psychological and behavioral information on Campers. If in the sole judgment of Camp California all information has not been provided accurately the camper is subject to dismissal with no refund on camp fees. Our guidance staff does not offer psychotherapy.
6. Camp California and its officers, directors, and employees, shall not be responsible for cellular phones, clothing, mail, packages, laundry, or other personal possessions lost or stolen, damaged by fire, malicious acts or personal neglect.
7. Campers or Parents/Guardians grant Camp California to use all videotape and photographs taken at camp (abiding by the parameters of the photo release form) for publicity and advertising purposes, without compensation to the camper or their Parents or Guardians. A photo release form must be signed and returned to Camp California, Camp California agrees to abide by the request of the parents/guardians or camper regarding personal images.
8. Camper, Parents/Guardians any dispute arises from this Application, the payment of fees, attendance at camp, or services provided, shall be determined exclusively by submission to mandatory, binding arbitration, instead of by lawsuit or resort to court action without limitation. By executing this application, camper, Parents/Guardians and Camp California are agreeing to have any controversies, claims or disputes arising between them decided by a neutral Arbitrator, and are giving up their rights to a court trial and jury, and instead are accepting binding Arbitration and the alternative mechanism for resolution. Any Arbitration proceeding initiated pursuant to this conditions of enrollment shall be conducted by a single Arbitrator, mutually selected in Ottawa, Ontario, whose fees will be shared equally. The Arbitrator's decision shall be conclusive, final and binding upon camper, Parents/Guardians and upon Camp California.
9. Commencement of Participation in Camp California is expressly conditioned on Camp California's receipt of a signed 2008 Application, a physician's executed Medical and Health History Form, a physician's executed release form and signed Camper Rules and Regulations form.
